

Trail Safety & Etiquette

All users please:

- Obey posted signs and trail regulations
- Stay on existing trails
- Tread lightly during wet and muddy conditions
- Be respectful of wildlife
- Respect private property. Many trails cross private land. Please respect this privilege by staying on designated trails.
- Stay right, except when passing
- Keep the trail litter free
- Report maintenance needs to GVLTF
- Be courteous to other trail users

Bicyclists please:

- Yield the right-of-way to pedestrians
- Stay to the right and pass on the left
- Pass others with care and give courteous verbal notice
- Slow down at trail intersections and congested areas
- Control your speed and be ready to stop if necessary
- Downhill riders yield to uphill riders
- Do not ride on muddy trails

Dog owners please:

- Pick up after your dog and dispose of waste properly
- Leash dogs except in designated off-leash areas
- Keep dogs under voice and sight command in designated off-leash areas
- Avoid encounters with wildlife and livestock.

Winter users please:

- Avoid walking or snowshoeing on groomed cross-country ski tracks
- Ski in control and always yield to pedestrians and slower-moving recreationists
- Ski in the indicated direction of traffic
